2 quarts of water

- I teaspoon of salt and pepper

Mix all the ingredients together and bring to a boil. Turn down to a simmer and let simmer for I hour. Season to taste with garlic powder, salt, and pepper.

Preheat Oven to 375. Butter one side of both pieces of bread and face it up. Place turkey, diced tomatoes, salt, pepper, and shredder mozzarella on top. Bake for 7 minutes.

Easy Peanut Butter Fudge

2 cups sugar

- 1/2 cup evaporated milk
- I cup peanut butter

Bring sugar and evaporated milk to a boil in sauce pan. Stir in peanut butter until smooth and remove from heat. Pour immediately into a buttered 8x8 dish. Let cool and serve. You can substitute sweetener for sugar.
