### Ingredients

- l cup margarine, melted
- 2 (15.25 ounce) cans creamed corn
- 2 eggs, beaten
- 1 (8 ounce) package dry corn bread mix
- l onion, finely chopped

### Directions

- 1. Preheat oven to 350 degrees F (175 degrees C).
- Melt margarine in a 9x13 inch baking dish. Add corn, eggs, corn bread mix, onion, salt and pepper and mix well.

Cover dish with aluminum foil and bake in preheated oven for about 40 minutes, or until firm.

### Easy Garlic Chicken

Ingredients

- 3 tablespoons butter
- 4 skinless, boneless chicken breast halves
- 2 teaspoons garlic powder
- 1 teaspoon seasoning salt

l teaspoon onion powder

Directions

Melt butter in a large skillet over medium high

heat. Add chicken and sprinkle with garlic powder, seasoning salt and onion powder. Saute about 10 to 15 minutes on each side, or until chicken is cooked through and juices run clear.

### Yummy Jello Cake

Make regular boxed yellowcake as directed in 13x9 pan. Prepare jello (any flavor) and pour over baked cake. Cool in fridge and top with whipped cream before serving.
